## **November 17, 2011 Annual History Meeting:**

Jim Slater from the Baltimore Metropolitan Council (and who was also represented Carroll County on the Reservoir Technical Group) has agreed to come speak to the general membership about the history of the Liberty Reservoir. We will also discuss the proposed changes to the Carroll County commissioner districts and how this would effect Finksburg.

## **Carroll County Re-Districting:**

Members of the county redistricting commission are proposing a map like the one 5 years ago that splits Finksburg in half between 2 commissioner districts There is another map that splits Finksburg into 3 different districts. Unfortunately the maps posted do not include roads or other identifying marks to clearly show this.
