The Carroll County Department of Planning, in conjunction with the Finksburg Citizens’ Council, was awarded the State of Maryland for a Facade Improvement Program. FIP offers grant funds to eligible property owners in the Finksburg Sustainable Community to improve the appearance of building facades and signs.

Goals of the program are to:

- »Encourage renovation of buildings and signs
- »Improve the appearance of the Finksburg Corridor
- »Leverage private improvement and revitalization efforts affordable and cost based

»Preserve and enhance economic vitality of commercial services

FIP offers an incentive dollar amount of up to 80% of the total cost of building facade and sign improvement.
